

## Scituate Youth Home After Exhaustive Search

At approximately 5:14 p.m. on Wednesday, June 24, 2009, a fourteen-year-old male from Scituate was reported missing to the Scituate Police Department. The youth had been at a friend's house and the last reported contact with him was alleged to have been 3:00 a.m., when he said that he was going to his girlfriend's house. Personnel from the Scituate Police Department, with the assistance of K-9 Units from Duxbury, Hingham, Hull, Plymouth County Sheriff's Department, Braintree and Rockland searched extensive areas of the town as leads developed in the investigation. The department requested the services of the Massachusetts State Police Air Wing to provide thermal imaging search capabilities, but weather conditions hampered their ability to respond. The Communicator reverse 9-1-1 system was also activated to generate information from residents who may have observed the boy. There was a positive resolution to the incident when, shortly after midnight, he called his home to request that he be picked up in Duxbury.
